poster format and requirements

Please ensure that your poster is no bigger than 2' x 4'. There is no capability to play videos or music; please do not send DVD or CD submissions. Keep extra copies of papers and photos at home.

What/how to submit: Mail your poster and on a separate sheet of paper (will not be displayed on the poster board), please list your name(s), address, phone number and e-mail address (optional).

Optional: If you want people from the conference to know that you did the poster, please just put your first name, age, and what city or town you are from.
